



Shaniko Holidays Chinese New Year

The Umatilla House in The Dalles was considered one of the finest Inns of Eastern Oregon in the later 1800's. The Shaniko town-site Company planned to build a hotel that would equal or exceed the comforts of that Inn.

Fen Batty, managing the Umatilla House was asked to come to Shaniko and manage the new hotel.

He did so and opened the hotel December 1901. Soon he owned the building located today in downtown Shaniko. Batty was a brother-in-law of the first cash store operator in Shaniko, A.C. Sanford, and his store still stands also south across from the hotel.

Little Alice Sanford recalled her uncle Fen's New Year's surprises in Helen Guyton Rees book, SHANIKO From Wool Capital to Ghost Town. "Uncle Fen must have loved the Chinese people, for two always worked for him in the kitchen, and he installed a laundry in Shaniko, run by Chinese. They always made the Chinese New Year seem like another Christmas for us children, when the camphor-wood chest arrived, filled with foreign silks, foods and dishes."
