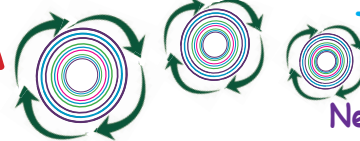

Freighting Dangers

As a freighter, it wasn't always the weather conditions or the dangers of accidents that threatened the safety of those in that traveling trade.

Mr. Enos Rose who was a story in early April, was once shot. He had arrived in Shaniko for a load and commenced on to the valley at the bottom of Cow Canyon. Today that is either 20 miles driving on Hwy 97 on the top and down the canyon, or 22 miles driving through Antelope and coming west out to Hwy 97. It was in that area where Mr. Rose camped for the night, heading back to Prineville, where he and his family lived.

The Crook County Journal reported on November 24, 1910, that a doctor was called on from Antelope to tend to a leg wound caused by a gunshot. No details about whether it was an accident or an altercation were given. But Mr. Rose had visited the Dell Eads Saloon near where he camped.

Held Hostage In The Dressing Room

If the sales lady told me one more time that the outfit I was viewing in the three-way mirror was “certainly body-friendly,” I was going to rip the velcroed shoulder pads out of the “body-friendly” outfit and politely stuff them in her “access ready” mouth.

On the surface the phrase seemed harmless enough. After all, she was just trying to be polite. It was her way of saying that the black, flowing material covered the mid-life marks of a few too many chips and dips. But after hearing the phrase ten times in three outfits, I had heard it nine times too many. Especially after flipping the “body-friendly” price tag over and realizing that it cost even more than that bottle of anti-aging creme I purchased in a moment of insecurity and financial irresponsibility. I rehashed the episode with a friend, and we decided that sales people attend seminars that teach them appropriate and tactful language.

You know what I mean. You come out of the dressing room looking drab and lumpy, wearing a sad, hopeless expression, and the sales person, in a flurry of motion, adds yet another set of shoulder pads, rolls or pushes up the sleeves, blouses the material at the waistline, stands the collar up, and *voila!* You seem to have shrunk.

It perks up my ego for a fraction of a second until I remember, *you were not born with the body-shrinking talent, Charley. You were simply born with the plump part of it.*

As I sit staring at the new outfit unbagged and draped across the living room couch....noticing the color isn’t what it appeared to be under the fluorescent lights in the dressing room.....I ponder the possible error in my judgment. Perhaps that annoying sales lady wasn’t so bad after all. Maybe I was just in a rotten mood. Maybe I should choke down my pride and take this blah-looking specimen back. Trade it for the black flowing thing. After all, considering that I’ve been gaining weight steadily for the last several over-forty years, I don’t own that many clothes that fit the way they used to. Appropriate things. Things that are forgiving. Things that are, shall we say, “body-friendly”.

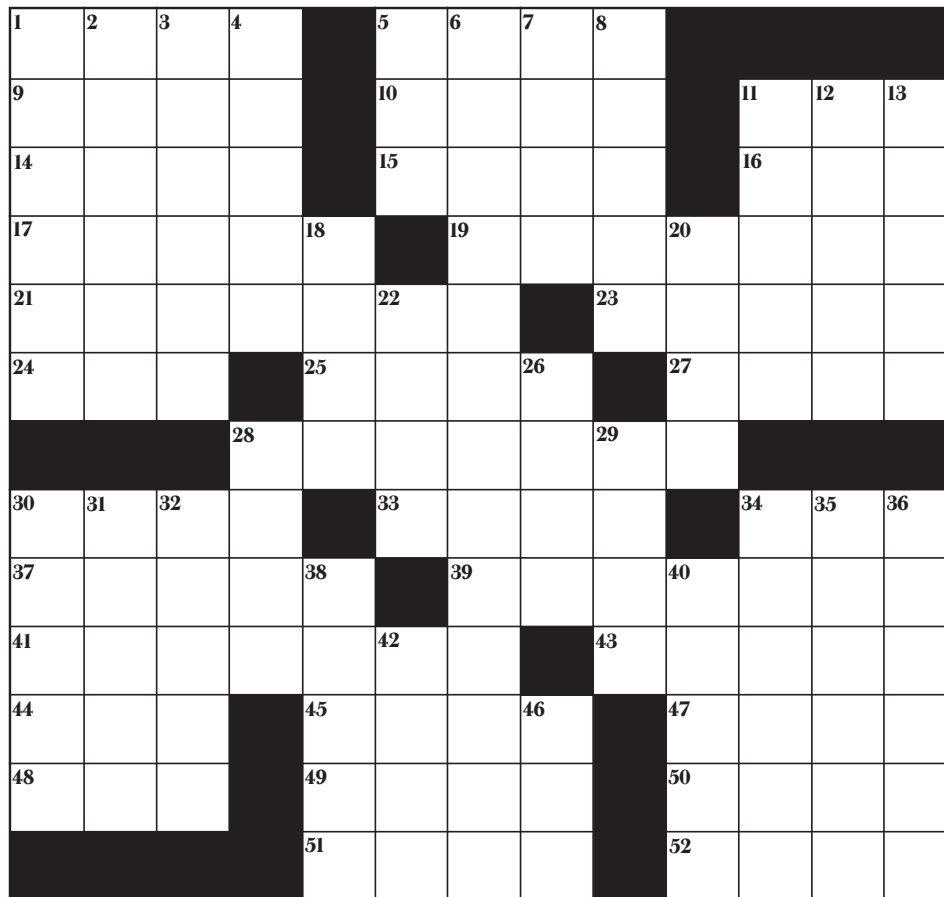
