



Happy Holidays Past: Antelope 1895

In January of 1896, The Dallas Weekly Chronicle reported holiday happenings from the Antelope community in December of 1985. In the column, "News Notes From Antelope" we learned that at the big hall (Duram's Hall) there were several activities executed. This was a long and large building that stood where the post office is now. Today the very old building next door was the Dial Saloon. In the early evening there were the traditional Christmas offerings of the holiday, the colored wax candles on a tree, Santa Claus came bearing gifts for the children, and the program that included singing of songs was presented.

After the program by the school children and staff concluded, a dance commenced that was held as a fundraiser for the minister of the town. The music was, "well rendered and appropriate." The community had a bad windstorm that week, a funeral, and some disruption in the school by late night use, that found books missing, creating an investigation to try and find the guilty persons.
