

### Shaniko: The Circus Came To Town: Part 2

Robert Altermatt wrote about attending a circus in Wasco. These types of unusual activities were often more memorable to report than holidays. Bob called them "Amusements" in his book. *Shaniko Remembered*. The town of Wasco in Sherman County had been selected for several visits by the A. G. Barnes Show. It was a full three ring circus. The visits were one day events. The typical side shows and popcorn stands were also offered.

Bob visited the unloading with the help of the elephants. He watched as the

tent pegs, "old automobile rear axles" were driven into the ground by a series of sledgehammer strikes by 3 or 4 men. The tent itself was raised by horses pulling on the support cables.

The noon parade of elephants ridden by pretty girls, cage wagons of lions and tigers were pulled along as was the band wagon. The Calliope was the "caboose" of the parade. Bob commented on, though not witnessed, some of the dangers associated with some of the acts. The trapeze artist falling to their deaths, a lion tamer's fate in the cage of a roaring and snarling lions and tigers.

Bob finished with, "Tusko, the largest elephant in the world stood wrapped in chains, all four feet shackled to stakes, large signs warned bystanders away," Bob read up about Tusko and learned the elephant was as big and uncontrollable as advertised.


