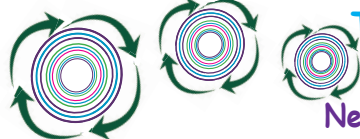

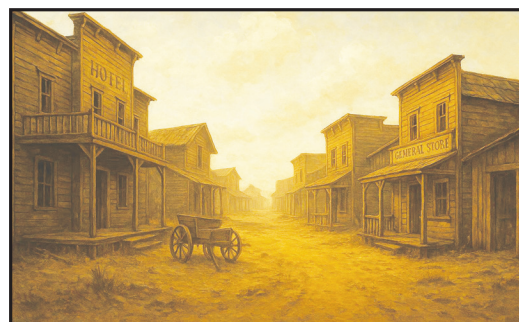


Historic short stories about Oregon's famous ghost town, Shaniko.

What is a ghost town?

The debate on what a ghost town
is was alive and well when I met Shaniko.

My instructor was Lambert Florin. He was born in
1905 and passed in 1993. His life spanned the better
part of Shaniko's history. Once he retired, he wrote 25
books dedicated to ghost towns. His writing career
produced 56 books of various historic themes.

In his most famous work, *Ghost Towns of the West*,
it was in that book that I learned Mr. Florin wisely
defined a ghost town as a shadow of its former glory. You
find them in three stages; a site on a map, an
uninhabited and decaying town, and an inhabited town functioning with historic structures
promoted or otherwise.

Settling that debate Mr. Florin's works would be instructive to the current marketing
myth coming out of Shaniko itself, that it is Oregon's oldest ghost town. Shaniko doesn't even
make the top ten list. AI assembled the illustration of a fictitious ghostly place, titled Ghost
Town Nowhere.

When I returned, there was another urgent call from my wife.

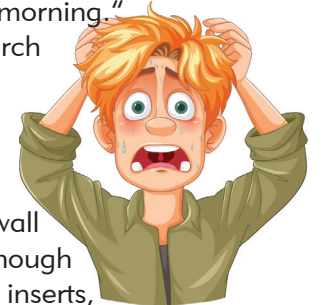
"Did you have a nice lunch?" she asked sweetly. I had had a marvelous steak, but knew better by now than to say so.

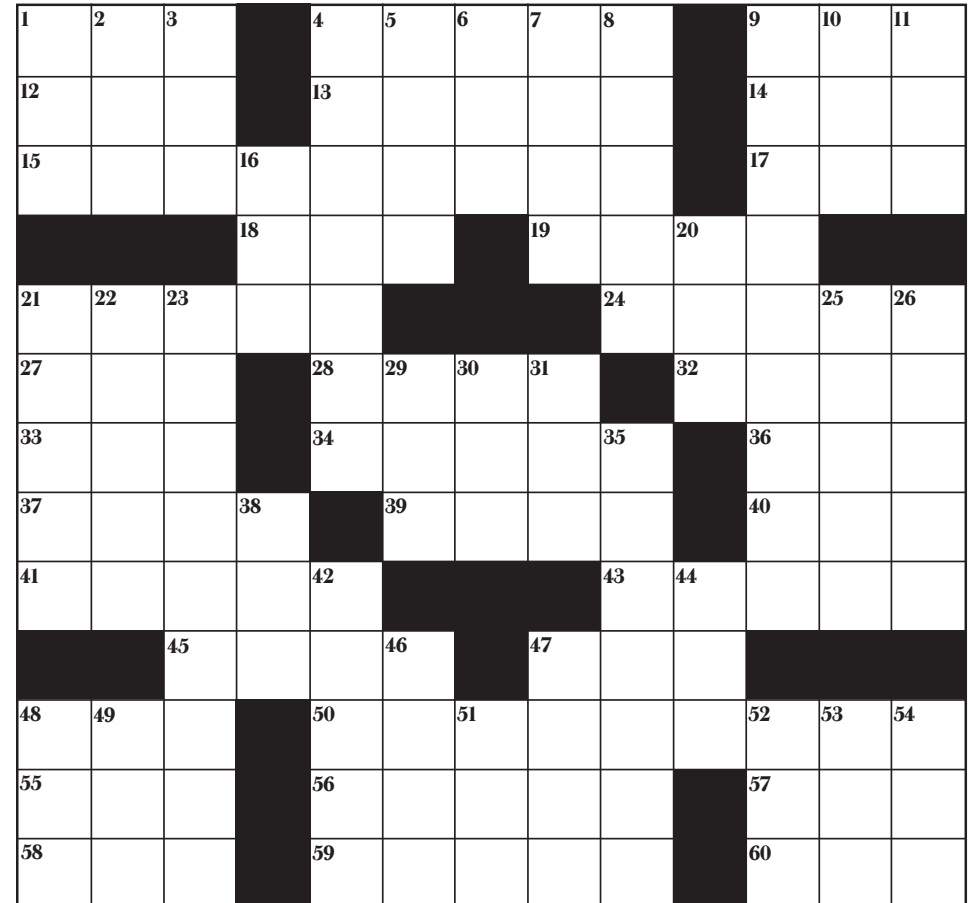
