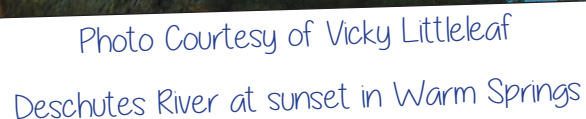

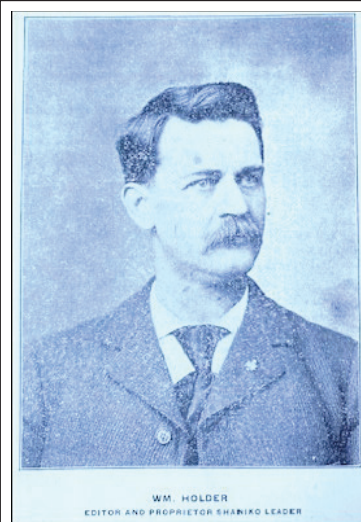

William Holder was the owner and publisher of The Shaniko Leader.

His choice to settle in Shaniko is printed in his first edition of what was called, THE SHANIKO

LEADER SOUVENIR EDITION released on January 1, 1901. "On the 19th day of April 1900, The Shaniko Leader launched its first number, and we fairly launched upon the broad sea of journalism. We fully realized at the time the grave responsibilities resting upon us in conducting a newspaper that would meet the approval of its readers as well as keeping abreast of the growing community we had decided to cast our lot with. From our ever-increasing subscription list we believe our efforts have been appreciated."

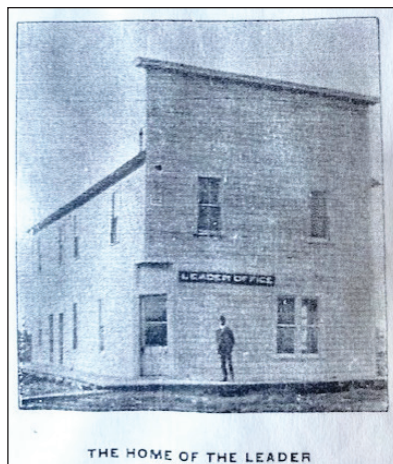
The Townsite Company built a building just east on the block the current "General Store" sits today. It sat north across from the old Rees home that also exists today on 5th and F streets. The store is an original building and the remnant of the bottom story of the Townsite building is the Shaniko Fire Hall. All of the building was recycled after it was first moved to the north end of the hotel and used as a hotel annex. It was there that the top half was used in the home built north of it and had three auto court cabins. The first business in the lower half was a garage in the 1920's and given to the City of Shaniko by Jean Farrell, restorer of the hotel in the 1980's. It was rolled across the street where it now sits, by Ed Martin.

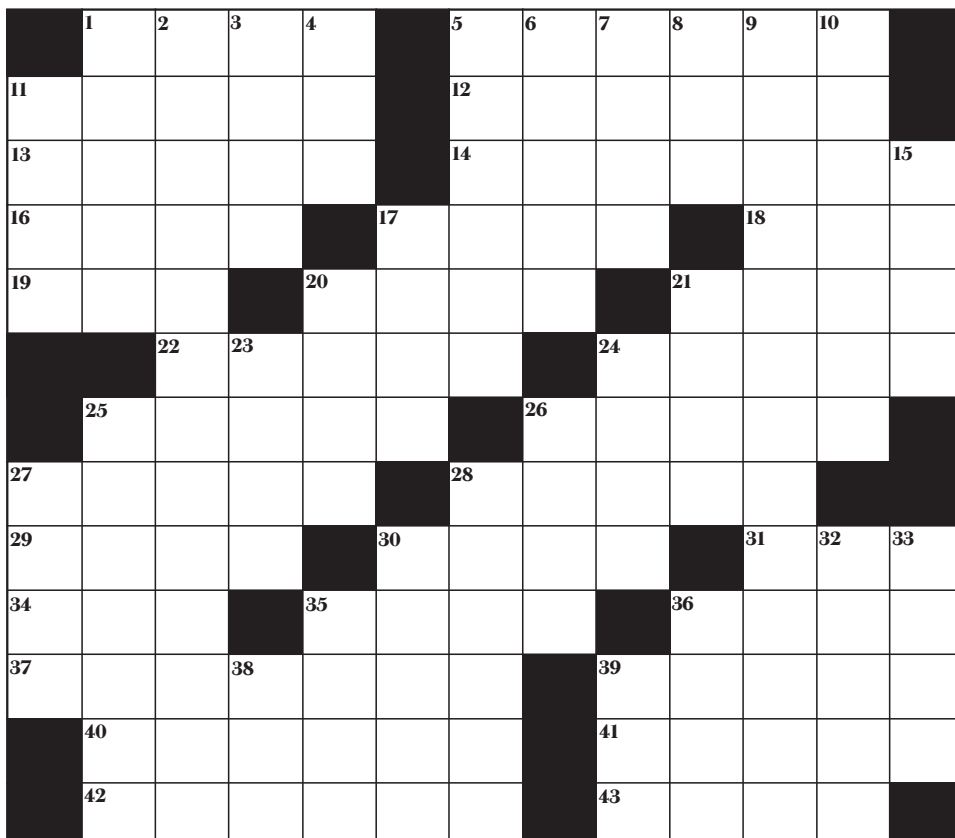

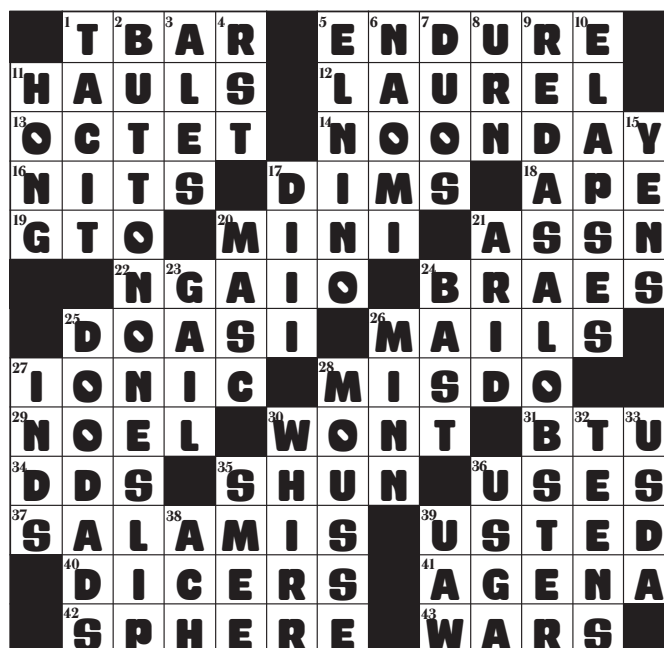
