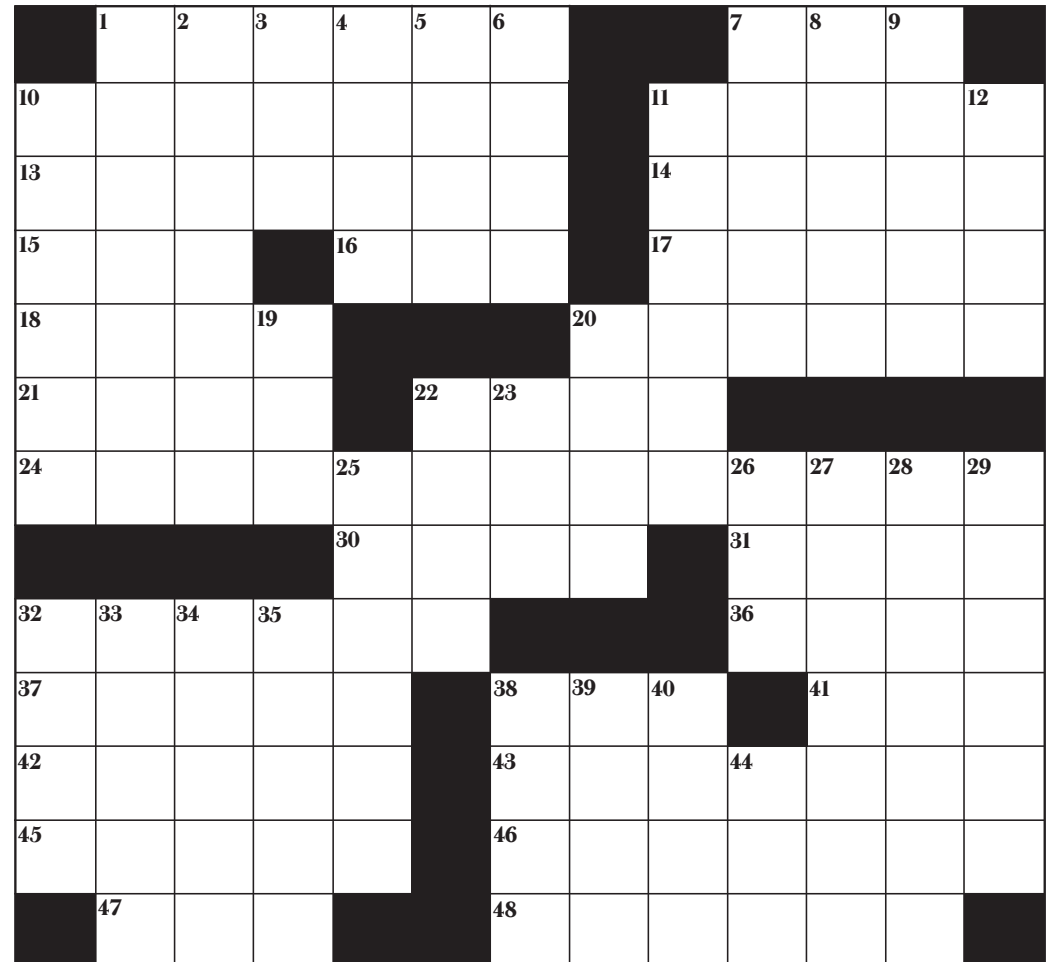

The Holder family consisted of the wife and five children. The county seat of Moro provided Wm. Holder the elected job of sheriff before he went into newspapering. He was traveling to towns in the central Oregon area and collecting information for his second 1902 Shaniko Leader Annual which gave lengthy excerpts of each county. By 1902 he had established the Moro Leader in 1902, the Prineville Review also in 1902. By the Shaniko Leader paper information it does not seem economically feasible to make a living in the newspaper business. Mr. Holder was a man of many means, however.

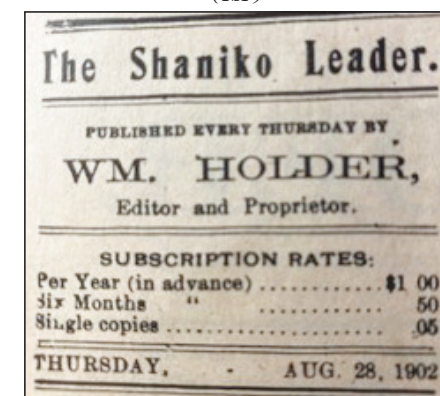
