Historic short stories about Oregon's famous ghost town, Shaniko.

The Shaniko Leader advertised alcohol and the places it could be obtained in the August 28, 1902 edition. The famed Silvertooth Saloon in Antelope put in a small version of business in Shaniko in the first few years of the new town. It was located a few doors east of the wooden Hotel Shaniko. The reception saloon was a few doors south of the Sanford Cash Store up near the intersection of the brick Columbia Southern Hotel. Both the Cash Store and the brick hotel exist today.

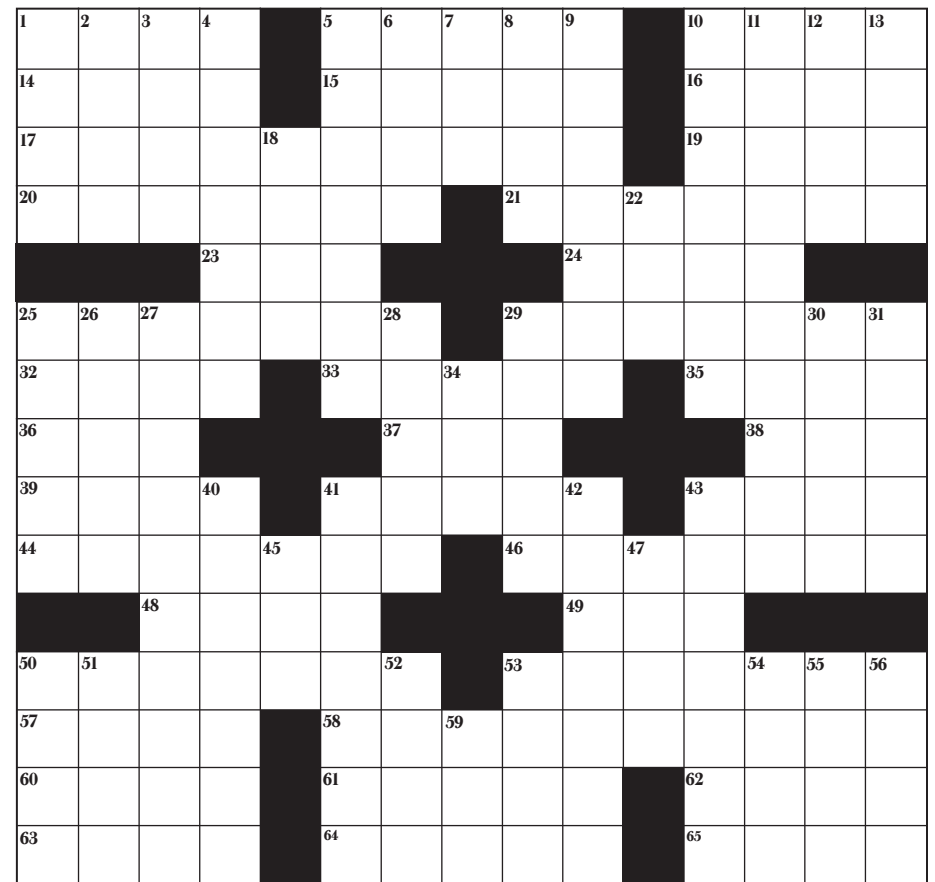
