





would be through Portland. Buyers saved money shipping by sea to Boston markets, especially once the Panama Canal was opened. Of course, the rail terminus in Shaniko took its rate. The article just said hauling was expensive. Raw wool, in its grease (lanolin) state, weighs 55-65% more than scoured or cleaned wool. The scouring plants in the Salem area could be utilized, or the bags of wool could be compressed into cubes for shipping out of Portland ports. *To be continued.*

Last Ghost Town

Just like any enterprise, costs are important to the bottom line. As a sheepman, ranchers invest in herds and grow their numbers hoping to increase their overall income over the years. Selling off male lambs for meat and selling wool by the pound was at the mercy of costs of shepherding, feeding, sheering, processing, freighting, and shipping by rail or boat for the rancher and the buyer.

The article from last week's piece, the writer for the Oregon Daily Journal in April of 1903 mentioned that shipping
