



## Shaniko: The Circus Came To Town: Part 1

The ghosts of Shaniko's past holiday activities would not be complete to leave out special events that also happened there. In June of 1899, The Dalles Daily Chronicle reported a circus train that came in from the east, stopping for a day in that city. There was reported in the "personals" that a M. B. Zumwalt of Tygh Valley, Charles Durbin of Antelope, and H.C. Rooper, associated with Antelope, brought his three children and three others. Nearly 4000 visitors filed into the town and saw the 4am arrival and unloading of the train cars. By 10am a parade a mile long went through a major route through town. The animals in cages, four brass bands, a mounted Calvary Troop, 15 elephants, a camel caravan, chime of bells, and a "screaming" Calliope mesmerized the crowds to attend the evening performance. The next day the circus train of the Ringling Brothers Circus headed west toward Portland.

So popular was this form of unusual entertainment, Shaniko itself had one visit. Must be if you had a train track they would come. On July 15, 1926, The Maupin Times reported on the Robinson & Shilders Circus that performed July 2nd. The report was, "their exhibitions were well appreciated by the publicum, which was present in quite a large number." No doubt in my mind!!!
