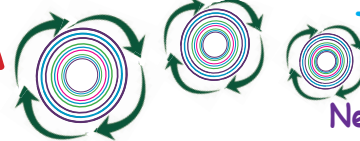

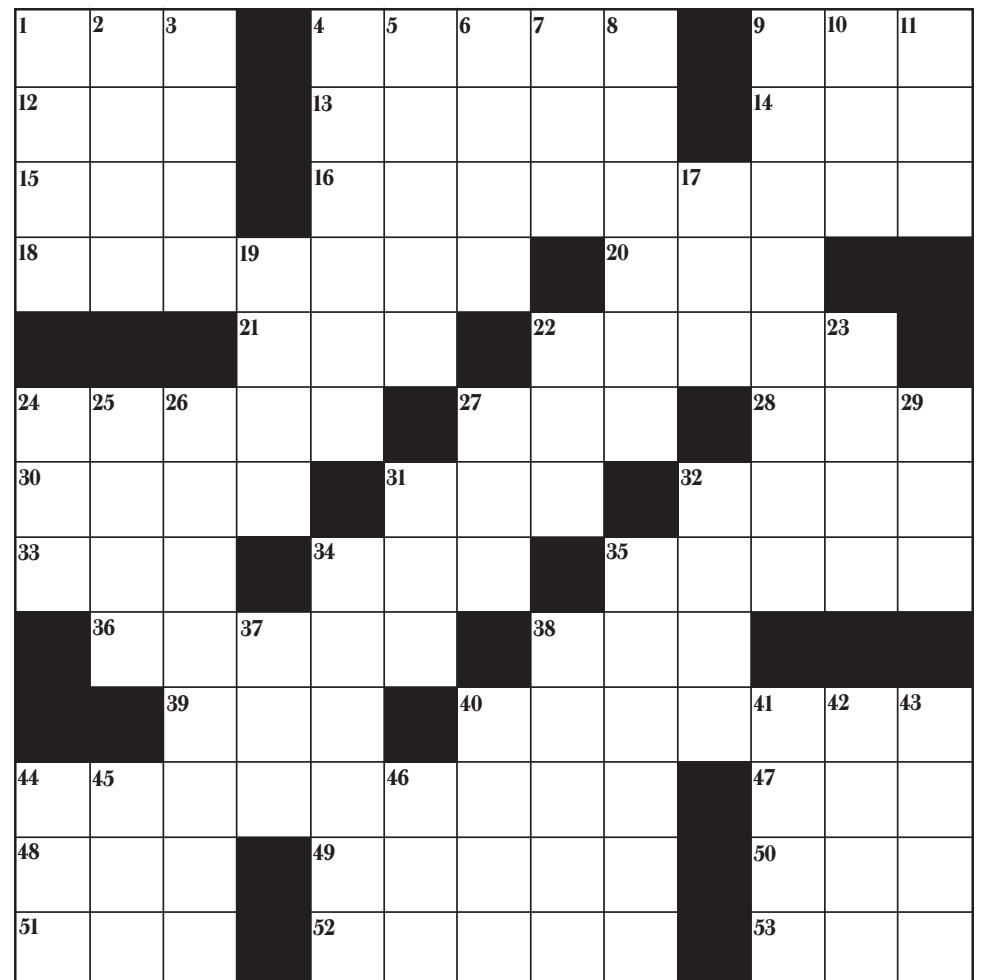

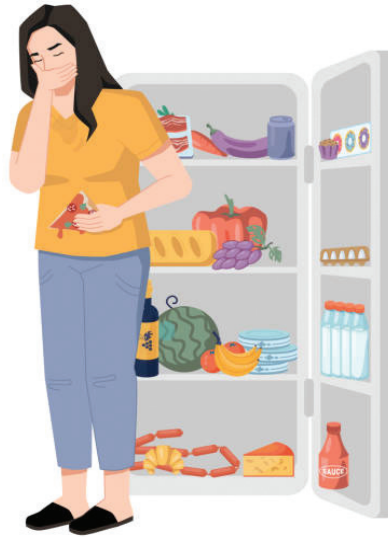
Of course, one of the downsides of keeping leftovers around too long is that, at some point (and you're never quite sure exactly when this point occurs), the edible becomes inedible.

On November 12, 1906, The Dalles Chronicle made mention, "The range in Shaniko section of the county is in a worse condition this fall than in years past, and sheep and cattlemen are certainly having a hard time of it trying to find grass sufficient to keep the stock alive until the snow falls when feeding begins."

A recent look at the 6-7 inch or less annual grasses this spring is already going to seed. Once the summer heat and what appears to be drought conditions fully come on, that part of winter feed will just burn up. Could this be a historic repeat? History does repeat and our weather patterns do too. Hopefully the rain will come on sufficiently to grow the bunchgrass.

Visiting the Sister's museum the ladies spoke of the summer grazing historically in the forest there for the central Oregon sheep ranchers (as forest service permits are allowed now for cattle). It was a nice connection to make for history's sake. As I travel through that area often now, their grass wouldn't offer much in summer pasture this year if that practice was still in place. The forest ground is very dry.
