Shaniko in the News

"Three Men Cited" Christmas day arrests for intoxication
numbered only three, Bend police reported today. Those
taken to the city jail for offense were Tim O'Flaherty, 40,
Shaniko sheepherder; A. McRenolds, 38, 1560 Newport Av-
enue; and Arthur A. Hudson, 30 a transient lineman. *The
Bend Bulletin, December 26, 1945.*

There was a record of arrest of Tim, claimed as a Bend
sheepherder, in December 11, 1945 he was with two differ-
ent men. Their fines were \$15.

March 8, 1946, of the same paper records, Tim again from
a Bond Street address was arrested for drunkenness. Police
calling him a frequent offender.

In May of 1947 again brought up on drunkenness
charges Tim got a fine of \$15 and 15 days in jail. He was as-
sociating with three others this time; men from New York,
California and a transient.

No more findings found for Tim O' from Bend. Maybe jail
time got his attention.


